Whole School Trip

The Whole School trip is planned for 17th July. Please ensure all money and consent forms are returned ASAP. We are hoping for a dry day so please ensure that you provide your child with a sunhat and suncream. The children will be transported to Queenswood by minibus. According to the government website

'Operators are not required to provide child seats. However, they may allow parents or others to supply their own child car seat for a use on a minibus journey.'

Therefore it is your responsibility to provide your child with a car seat on the day if wish them to use one.

Absence

Please ensure that you ring the Absence Line on the morning of your child's absence **by 9:30am**

Morning Routine

Please explain the information below to your child as there are still a number of school aged children using the main playground to play before the start of school at 8:55am.

To ensure the safety of all children in the morning, children wishing to run around or socialise with their

friends should be on the playground opposite Breakfast/After school Club mobile. There is a member of staff on duty from 8:45am so if you wish to leave your child at this time, please ensure they are taken to this playground.

School Uniform

Just a reminder as to what to get ready for the start of the Autumn term.

Please ensure that your child wears the correct school uniform to school each day including the correct footwear;

- Green Check Summer dress
- Green sweatshirt (or cardigan)
- Gold poloshirt/shirt/blouse
- Grey skirt/pinafore/straight leg trousers/shorts
- Reversible Jacket
- Polishable black shoes/boots (No Ugg-type unsupported boots).

Also please ensure that your child has the correct PE Kit – Plain black shorts/skirt, plain white t-shirt and black pumps. For outdoors + Jogging bottoms and black/white trainers. It is also important that long hair is tied back. Thank you.

Can I also remind you that headwear should be gold or green in line with the school uniform policy. Headbands should also be plain.

Nuts

Please refrain from sending nuts or food items containing nuts into School for the safety of pupils who are allergic to nuts. Thank you.

Data Protection

We are quite happy for you to photograph your own child/children when they are taking part in school events. However, please do not upload any images onto global sites such as Youtube, Facebook, etc., as you could be contravening data protection legislation.

At the End of the Day

It is so nice to see so many children making use of the playground at the end of the day but **please can we ask that if children use any of our equipment that it is put away safely. There is still a lot of equipment not being put away properly.** Please remember that your child's safety is your responsibility during this time of play. Thank you.
